For members intending to drive there, there are several car parks in the immediate vicinity. Den Haag Hollands Spoor station is also within easy walking distance. The restaurant is located on the 42nd floor.

The cost of the evening, covering a sumptuous three-course meal, wine and coffee is \in 70 per person for members. A member can optionally bring one guest, also at \in 70. Any further guests (who can be accommodated only if space permits, so no guarantee) will pay \in 80; the same applies to anyone wanting to come to the event before applying for membership of the society.
